## **OUR SIGNATURE AWARDS PROGRAMS**

S.I. Thunder Bay distributes community awards to women every year. Many of the women chosen have triumphed over daunting challenges. The awards help our recipients to cultivate new skills, further their education and regain independence.



Live Your Dream is a monetary award that assists women in improving their education, skills and employment prospects. Eligible applicants must

be women who provide the primary financial support for their families and who are enrolled in, or have been accepted to, a vocational/skills training program or an undergraduate degree program.

Applications are available throughout the year at all local educational facilities, through club members and on-line. Applications are reviewed by a panel of selected judges. Winners are recognized at an annual awards dinner.



**Dream It, Be It – Career Support for Girls** helps girls grow up to be strong, successful, happy adults. It targets girls in the community who face obstacles to their future success. It provides girls with access to professional role models, career education and the resources to live their dreams. Soroptimist clubs will work in partnership with girls in small groups or a conference setting to provide them with the information and resources they want and need to be successful. The topics covered include career opportunities, setting and achieving goals, overcoming obstacles to success and how to move forward after setbacks or failures.
